ADVANCED COURSEWORK / DUAL-CREDIT OPTIONS

HONORS COURSES / WEIGHTED GPA

These are advanced courses that move at a faster pace, cover material in greater depth, and receive additional GPA weight, which awards extra points for honors-level coursework.
