### Honor Academy

The Honor Academy at Living Word is a unique curricular concept designed for students who desire academic rigor and the opportunity to pursue their passions in a particular academic area. Opportunities for students to personalize the Academy to fit their passions allow students to thrive.

### **Dual Credit Programs**

Living Word partners with Concordia University Wisconsin (online & on-campus classes), and UW-Oshkosh (CAAP program) to provide courses that students may take for dual high school and college credit.

#### Resource

Resource Study Hall is a class designed to reinforce concepts that are taught in the classroom and give them extra time and resources to succeed. This is available for students with IEPs or service/accommodation plans.

#### Winterim

Each year in January, students take a three-week intensive course of their choice, before the start of the second semester. Courses vary from year to year. Every class offers an interactive, hands-on learning environment, both inside and outside the classroom, with field trips and projects.
